Text Truth: Jesus told people that God sent Him.

Bible Verse: He has appointed me to preach good news to the poor.

Luke 4:18a

Bible Verse Paraphrase: Jesus said, "God has sent Me to preach good news." Luke 4:18a

LUKE 4:14-22

Jesus said, "The words I spoke are true."


