**Text Truth:** Isaiah told how God's Son would help people.

**Bible Verse:** **The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and to give his life. Matthew 20:28**

**Bible Verse Paraphrase:** **Jesus came to serve and give His life. Matthew 20:28**

**ISAIAH 7:14; 9:6-7; 11:1-4,10; 53:3-5**

Isaiah knew God planned to send His Son, Jesus, to help people. God showed Isaiah the things Jesus would do. Isaiah wrote about these things. Jesus would be wise because God would be with Him. Jesus would serve people while He lived on earth.

Isaiah said that Jesus would teach people to know God and love and obey Him. Jesus would be kind and care about people who were hurting or sick. Isaiah told people God's Son, the Messiah, would lead people to do what is right. Jesus would be the One people trusted to help them. Many people would love Jesus and worship Him.

But God also showed Isaiah how some people would treat Jesus. Isaiah wrote about these things, too.

Isaiah said that Jesus grew up like other people—Jesus didn't look like someone who would be a king. People turned their backs on Jesus and did not believe He was God's Son, the Messiah. People were angry when Jesus healed the sick and taught about obeying God's laws. Some people laughed at Jesus and made fun of Him. Some people hurt Jesus and called Him names.

But Jesus did not open His mouth. He knew all the bad things were a part of God's plan for Him.

Isaiah said that Jesus would suffer for people because Jesus loved the people and cared about them. And God would be pleased with Jesus.
