Big Question: What is your plan for yourself?

Text: Luke 14:28-33 (NKJV)

• For which of you, **intending** to build **a tower**, does not **sit down first** and **count** the cost, whether he has **enough** to finish it—29 lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to **finish**, all who see it begin to mock him, 30 saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.' 31 Or what king, going to make war against another king, does not sit down first and consider whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? 32 Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks conditions of peace. 33 So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple.

Seven Signs You Have Healthy Plans

- 1. Your Plans Are Specific (He mentions "a tower")
 - Luke 14:28 (NKJV): 28 For which of you, **intending** to build a **tower**, does not **sit down** first and **count** the cost, whether he has **enough** to finish it—29 lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, 30 saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.'
 - 31 Or what king, going to make war against another king, does not sit down first and consider whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand?
- 2. Your Plans Are Intentional (Decide where you want to go and don't just react)
- 3. Your Plans Are **Maturely Analyzed** (You first sit down)
- **4**. Your Plans Are **Rightly Priced** (You count the Cost)





- **5**. Your Plans Are **Honest** (You tell yourself the truth)
- **6**. Your Plans Are To **Finish** (v29-30)
- 7. Your Plans Prepare You For Vulnerable Seasons (When you don't have the power)
 - 32 Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and **asks conditions of peace.**
 - 33 So likewise, whoever of you does not **forsake all** that he has cannot be My disciple.
