5. How do you stop others from making bad decision? (Advise them, pray for them, and wait and see)
6. Is it your responsibility to save people from bad decisions (sometimes yes and sometimes know)
7. What if you mapped, predicted, and decided and you still made the wrong decision? (Keep trying)
