


DANIEL CHOSE TO OBEY

DANIEL 1

Daniel lived in the city of Jerusalem. He loved God and learned about the laws and commands God gave His people when they left Egypt. Daniel obeyed God's commands.

When Daniel was a teenager, the king in the country of Babylon marched to Jerusalem. The king's soldiers took Daniel and many other people back to Babylon to be servants. The king had a plan for young men like Daniel who were from important families and who were strong and wise.

Daniel and three of his friends were chosen to be trained to serve the king. Every day the king's officials taught the young men a new language and stories from Babylon's history. Daniel and his friends were given new names, too.
