
PEOPLE LEARNED WHO TO OBEY

GALATIANS 2-3

Paul loved Jesus and wanted to tell people the good news— Jesus is God's Son and the One God sent to help people. Paul knew that Jesus came to help everyone. When people believed in Jesus, they would have joy and peace and love one another. They would be in God's family forever.

Paul traveled to many places to visit churches and help them learn about Jesus. Paul began to write letters to the churches, too.

Paul wrote his first letter to some churches in a place called Galatia. Paul had heard some news that bothered him—the people in the churches were arguing and disagreeing about the laws that God gave to Moses.


To Paul, this sounded like the people had forgotten why God had given the laws to His people in the first place. Paul had to remind the people that the laws were given to help people obey God until Jesus came. After Jesus came, people were to obey what Jesus taught and have faith in Him.

In his letter to the people in Galatia, Paul said, "I am amazed that you are turning away from the truth. Believing in Jesus and following Him is more important than obeying the laws God gave long ago. We must have faith in Jesus only. Jesus will show us how to live."

Paul wanted to help the people in Galatia know the truth and live like Jesus taught.
