GALATIANS 5-6

Paul really cared about the church people in Galatia and wanted them to understand how to live for Jesus. Paul wrote more in his letter. This time he wrote about showing love and helping one another.

"Stand strong, friends. Serve one another through love. Remember that Jesus taught us to love our neighbor as ourselves," wrote Paul.

Paul asked the church people to treat others fairly and help them.


