III. Seven Things That Can Affect Your Work

<u>Text</u>: **Ecclesiastes 9:10:** Whatever turns up, grab it and do it. And heartily! This is your last and only chance at it, For there's neither work to do nor thoughts to think In the company of the dead, where you're most certainly headed. (The Message Version)

Ecclesiastes 9:10 (NKJV): Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might; for there is no work or device or knowledge or wisdom in the grave where you are going.

- 1. Clarity (Do you know what you are doing?)
- **2.** Support (Who is holding up your arms; Exodus 17:12-14)
- **3.** Time (How much time do you give to working?)
- **4.** Knowledge (How much do you really know?)
- **5.** Truth (Do you know the truth about your work; John 8:32)
- **6.** Opportunity (Have you created opportunities?)
- **7.** Re-tooling (What needs to be replaced in your life?)

- 2. She had to **find work** (Naomi partnered with her by giving advice; Ruth 2)
