

## **Deciding to Have Power**

Date: June 29-30, 2019

**Big Question**: How much power have you decided to have in your life? **Side Question**: How much power has God made available to you?

Series Text: Ephesians 6:10 <u>Finally</u>, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. <sup>11</sup>Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. (NKJV)

**Today's Text: Acts 1:8** "But <u>you shall receive power</u> when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Note: True power is all about being a witness for Him.

• Power Defined: Greek word <u>Dunamis</u>; might; strength; faculty; wealth, property; competent; brave; landowner; army; upper class; military service; campaign; military men, troops; heavenly bodies, heavenly entourage; compulsory labor;

**Setting**: Jesus had just risen from the dead (Acts 1:1-7)

- 1. You must decide you want to be <u>strong</u> (This is a decision only you can make)
- 2. You must decide to have power; especially God's power in your life (Acts 1:8)
- 3. You must decide to regroup after a difficult season (The disciples had to regroup) (Acts 1:9-26)
- 4. You must decide to replace what you can't change (Judas had to be replaced)

# **Seven Test Questions About The Power in Your Life**

- 1. Do you have power over your time? (What are you doing with your time?)
- 2. Do you have power over your health? (What are you doing to yourself physically?)
- 3. Do you have power over your freedom? (What criminal activity are you tempted to join in?)
- 4. Do you have power over your choice of friends? (What kind of friends have you chosen?)
- 5. Do you have power over what is on your mind? (What are you feeding your mind?)
- 6. Do you have the power to make one decision and change your life? (What is that decision?)
- 7. Have you made yourself available to God's presence and power in your life?



## Closing

#### Five Things That Prove You Don't Have Power

- 1. An emotional outburst does not prove you have spiritual or practical power in your life
- 2. Complete silence, tightening your face, and stiffening your body is not a sign of power
- 3. Loud outburst, demonstrative dancing (can be nice), but it is not a sign of power
- 4. Long scriptural or long philosophical conversations that have great truth is not a sign of power
- 5. Lengthy church membership, long-term service on a job, a big family, a big car, a big home, preaching, teaching, or singing is not a sign of power

Note: Even though these things can be good.

Note: Healthy fruitful results are the only thing that prove you have power

• Matthew 7: 16 "You will know them by their fruits (or results)." (NKJV)

**Question**: What are your life results so far?

**Next Time:** Deciding to Have Power Over Your Real Enemy

**Big Question:** Who is your real enemy? (Is it your spouse, family, friends, job, or neighbor?) **Answer**: **No**, your enemy is principalities, powers, rulers of the darkness, and spiritual hosts
