#### Jeremiah 29:7

• 7 Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper."

### I. Maturity Described

# 1. Mature People Accept What Cannot Be Changed Today

- A. They were more than likely going to die in slavery
- B. They were **not going to receive a great deliverance** for seventy years
- C. They were **laying a foundation someone else would benefit** from

### 2. Mature People Invest with Tomorrow in Mind

- A. **Seek prosperity** while in captivity (Make the most of this season)
- B. See God's hand in this season ("I have carried you into exile")
- C. Remember **your prosperity is linked** to the world around you (v7)

### 3. Mature People Have Action Plans for The Future

- A. We must be **prepared to manage this season** longer than we planned or desired
- B. We must find creative ways to negotiate this season without fear
- C. We must **learn from this season** and pass this wisdom to the next generation





## II. Maturity not Applied

- 1. Some people would rather take the risk of death than change
- 2. Some people would rather play doctor than seek advice from a professional
- 3. Some religious people would rather gather with no precautions than live
- 4. Some people would rather die broke than repent and change their approach to living
- 5. Some people would rather sacrifice their spiritual message for a political preference
