
## JEREMIAH'S SCROLL



Text Truth: God's Word (the Bible) will never go away.

Bible Verse: My words will never pass away. Matthew 24:35

Bible Verse Paraphrase: God's words will never go away.

Matthew 24:35

## **JEREMIAH 36**

Jeremiah loved God and did what God said to do. One day God gave Jeremiah an important job.

God wanted Jeremiah to help people know they should stop doing things that were not right. God told Jeremiah, "Take a scroll and write on it all the words I have told you about the people. Do not be afraid. I will be with you. Then maybe the people will change and do right."

So Jeremiah called his helper Baruch to write on the scroll. Every word God told Jeremiah is what Baruch wrote on the scroll. (The words Baruch wrote are in our Bible today.)

Then Jeremiah told his helper to take the scroll to the temple and read the words to the people.

One of the king's helpers read the words on the scroll to the king. The king did not like what the scroll said. The king became angry. He cut the scroll into pieces and threw them into the fire.

God told Jeremiah to get another scroll and write all the words again. So again Baruch wrote everything Jeremiah said.

## THEBIBLE

God's words are in the Bible. Jesus said, "God's words will never go away."

Tools: paper, unused trash bag

- ☐ Write each word of the Memory Verse on a piece of paper. Crumple up the pieces and place them in a trash bag. Prepare one bag for each team.
- Form two or more teams.
- Guide teams to line up in relay form with their trash bags across the room from them.
- At your signal, the first person in each group will run to their trash bag and pull out one piece of paper.
- When he returns, he must tag the next team member before she can run to get a second piece of paper.
- After the trash bag is empty, the team must work together to put the verse in order.
- Conclude: "No matter what people try to do, no matter what some people think about God's Word, no matter what people do to God's Word, whether they burn it or crumple it up and throw it away, God's Word cannot be destroyed."
