I. Four Things To Consider Re-defining When Looking at Cash and Debt (Proverbs 22:7, 6:1-11)

- 1. Freedom (The Rich, the poor, the borrower)
 - Proverbs 22:7: The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is slave to the lender.

2. Co-signing traps

• Proverbs 6:1–11 (NIV): 6 My son, if you have **put up security** for your neighbor, if you have shaken hands in pledge for a stranger, 2 you have been **trapped** by what you said, ensnared by the words of your mouth. 3 So do this, my son, to **free yourself**, since you have fallen into your neighbor's hands:

3. Diligent exhaustion,

• Go—to the point of **exhaustion**— and give your neighbor no **rest**! 4 Allow no **sleep** to your eyes, no slumber to your eyelids. 5 **Free yourself**, like a gazelle from the hand of the hunter, like a bird from the snare of the fowler. 6 Go to the ant, you **sluggard**; consider its ways and be wise!

4. Self-Motivation

• 7 It has no commander, **no overseer** or ruler, 8 yet **it stores its provisions** in summer and **gathers its food** at harvest. 9 How long will you lie there, you **sluggard**? When will you get up from your sleep? 10 A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to rest—11 and poverty will come on you like a thief and scarcity like an armed man.

Why Christians Struggle With Cash and Debt


- 1. **Confusing Theology** (1 Timothy 6:9-10)
 - 10 For the love of **money is a root of all kinds of evil.** Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.
- 2. Naive Optimism: Because I pray and have faith no weapon formed against my finances will prosper.
- 3. No Financial plan or strategy (What are your annual savings goals and plans for this year?)
