Note: Important Foundational Understanding

• The problem is that too many people are looking for "salvation by government." They are putting their hope in the political realm. But God warns us that when we put our confidence in kings bad things can happen (see 1 Samuel 8:9–18). There is no such thing as salvation by government (see Judges 8:22–23).

Note: Three Facts That Must Be Clear About Voting and Politics


- 1. Voting, as we know it, **did not exist** during any period in history prior to 1776
- 2. Politics by definition has to do with the "affairs of the cities"
- 3. Politicians are people who are appointed to handle our issues

I. God Gave Specific Guidelines On How to Govern (Deuteronomy 4:5-9)

5 See, I have taught you decrees and laws as the Lord my God commanded me, so that you may follow them in the land you are entering to take possession of it. 6 Observe them carefully, for this will show your wisdom and understanding to the nations, who will hear about all these decrees and say, "Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people." 7 What other nation is so great as to have their gods near them the way the Lord our God is near us whenever we pray to him? 8 And what other nation is so great as to have such righteous decrees and laws as this body of laws I am setting before you today? 9 Only be careful, and watch yourselves closely so that you do not forget the things your eyes have seen or let them fade from your heart as long as you live. Teach them to your children and to their children after them.

Note: We Are Not God and We Can Get Our Laws Wrong: Our laws are not the same as the laws described here. We at various times in history voted to implement certain laws (e.g. slavery, segregation, chauvinism, 120,000 Japanese internment from 1942-1946, pollution, etc.)





II. God Gave Specific Consequences for Not Governing Properly (Daniel 4:28-34)

28 All this happened to King Nebuchadnezzar. 29 Twelve months later, as the king was walking on the roof of the royal palace of Babylon, 30 he said, "Is not this the great Babylon I have built as the royal residence, by my mighty power and for the glory of my majesty?"

31 Even as the words were on his lips, a voice came from heaven, "This is what is decreed for you, King Nebuchadnezzar: Your royal authority has been taken from you. 32 You will be driven away from people and will live with the wild animals; you will eat grass like the ox. Seven times will pass by for you until you acknowledge that the Most High is sovereign over all kingdoms on earth and gives them to anyone he wishes."33 Immediately what had been said about Nebuchadnezzar was fulfilled. He was driven away from people and ate grass like the ox. His body was drenched with the dew of heaven until his hair grew like the feathers of an eagle and his nails like the claws of a bird. 34 At the end of that time, I, Nebuchadnezzar, raised my eyes toward heaven, and my sanity was restored. Then I praised the Most High; I honored and glorified him who lives forever. His dominion is an eternal dominion; his kingdom endures from generation to generation.

III. Jesus Gave Specific Instructions on How To Honor Government (Mark 12:17)

17 Then Jesus said to them, "Give back to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's." And they were amazed at him.
