I. The Hindrance to Habakkuk's Dream

Habakkuk 1:1–4 (NKJV)

1. He was Burdened

• v1 The burden which the prophet Habakkuk saw. The Prophet's Question 2 O Lord, how long shall I cry, And You will not hear? Even cry out to You, "Violence!" And You will not save.

2. He was Surrounded With Strife

- v3 Why do You show me iniquity, And cause me to see trouble? For plundering and violence are before me; There is strife, and contention arises.
- v4 Therefore **the law is powerless**, And justice never goes forth. For the wicked surround the righteous; **Therefore perverse judgment proceeds.**

II. God's Plan for Habakkuk's Future

Habakkuk 1:5-6 (NKJV)

1. God Planned to Intervene

• v5 "Look among the nations and watch—Be utterly astounded! For <u>I will work a work in your days Which</u> you would not believe, though it were told you.

2. God Planned a Painful Solution

• v6 For indeed I am raising up the Chaldeans, A bitter and hasty nation Which marches through the breadth of the earth, To possess dwelling places that are not theirs.





III. God's Plan For Habakkuk <u>Described</u> Habakkuk 2:2–4 (NKJV):

1. The plan of God was written

• 2 Then the Lord answered me and said: **"Write the vision** And **make it plain** on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

2. The plan of God was guaranteed

• 3 For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry.

3. The plan of God required faith

• 4 "Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith.

IV. Four Things That Could Have Easily Hindered God's Plan For My Future

1. My Age

- I was **twenty-two** when I got married
- I was **twenty-three** when I started pastoring

2. My Real Estate Exposure (Pastors manage a lot of real estate)

- I had never **closed a property** until our first facility on Eastbroad Street (I was 25 years old)
- I had only lived in **apartments** until I got married (I was 28 years old)

3. My Business Experience

- I had **no business mentoring**
- I had no real **business or management experience** (But, I understood how to work)

4. My Academic Strength (I was not mentored early in life to be an excellent student)

• I was a "C" student with "A" potential (All I needed was a plan)

V. God's Plan That Changed My Life

- 1. He planned a new **social environment** for me (He gave me new **friends**)
- 2. He planned a new **academic environment** for me (He put me in a **fun** learning environment)
- 3. He planned a new **spiritual environment** for me (This made learning about God very **practical**)
- 4. He planned a new love focus for me (I came off the field and settled with **Diane**; the gift of my life)
