Series Summary: Four Things That Will Help You Move Forward

- A. Forgetting (Requires a high level of maturity to let things go)
- B. Reaching (Requires a clear sense of direction- you can only reach for what you can see!)
- C. Pressing (Requires a stubborn level of grit)
- **D.** Believing (Requires unwavering faith)

Series Text: Philippians 3:13-14

• 13 Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

Note: Enoch is an example of a prize winner that impressed and pleased God

Question: Do you believe there is a prize for you?

Today's Text: Hebrews 11:5–7 (NIV)

• 5 By faith Enoch was taken from this life, so that he did not experience death: "He could not be found, because God had taken him away." For before he was taken, he was commended as one who pleased God.

Today's Big Lesson: You will limit your potential if you don't believe

• 6 And <u>without faith it is impossible</u> to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

Big Question: What made Enoch's commitment to believe unique enough to mention?

1. Note: His Family Background

I. His Father, by Our Standards, Was a Late Family Planner

A Child Is Born to Jared named Enoch at 162 years old

• Genesis 5:18–24 (NIV): 18 When Jared had lived 162 years, he became the father of Enoch. 19 After he became the father of Enoch, Jared lived 800 years and had other sons and daughters. 20 Altogether, Jared lived a total of 962 years, and then he died.

II. Enoch, by His Family's Standard, Was an Early Family Planner

• 21 When Enoch had lived 65 years, he became the father of Methuselah. 22 After he became the father of Methuselah, Enoch walked faithfully with God 300 years and had other sons and daughters.

III. Enoch, by His Family's Standard, Died Young Compared to His Dad who Died at 962 (Gen. 5:20)

• 23 Altogether, Enoch lived a total of 365 years. 24 Enoch walked faithfully with God; then he was no more, because God took him away.

Note: To them he died or disappeared in the prime of his life.

2. Note: His Unique Spiritual Testimony:

- Genesis says, he walked faithfully with God (Genesis 5:24)
- Hebrews says he was a man of great faith that worked to please God (Hebrews 11:5)
- By faith Enoch was taken from this life, so that he did not experience death: "He could not be found, because God had taken him away." For before he was taken, he was commended as one who pleased God.
